

PSSD10 Poker Tour 2020

Frequently Asked Questions

*** Please note that there will be no physical playing cards handed out at each stop. Your hand(s) will be given to you at Grand Tappattoo when you are checked in to the final stop.
The stops will be initialling your cards as you go.

Q1: What are the stops this year?

A1: For the "2020 PSSD10 Poker Tour", the following stops will be available:

- The Cove Marine and Recreation Center (Trail 15)
- Muskoka Station Store (Trail 9 to downtown MacTier)
- H&H Restaurant (Trail 16)
- Memories of Muskoka (C Trail / Trail 201)
- Rosseau Road Powersports and Marine (C Trail)
- Super 8 (C Trail)
- Boston Pizza (C-Alt Trail)
- Nobel Self Storage (C-Alt Trail)
- Carling Trail Blazers Trailside Stop (Intersection of 401/406/404 Trails)
- Loggers Station House (C104D Trail)
- Duck Rock / Ducks Nest (C104D Trail)
- Magnetawan Grill & Grocery (C104D Trail)
- Magnetawan Building Ctr (C104D Trail)
- Kirks Gas (D Trail)
- Final Stop Grand Tappattoo Resort (Trail 211)

Q2: Is there an age restriction on the Poker Tour?

A2: Yes, participants in the Poker Tour must be 18 years of age or older. Parents or guardians are welcome to carry more than one hand, but participants that are not 18 are not eligible to win.

Q3: Is my card still valid if it is not signed?

A3: The card must be initialed by the official in order to qualify. There will be no exceptions.

Q4: What time does the Poker Tour start and finish?

A4: The Poker Tour starts at 9:00 am and all stops close at 4:00 pm.

Q5: Can I draw all of my cards at the Final Stop?

A5: Yes, as much as we'd love for you to make it out onto the trails we understand that may not be possible for everyone so you can come to Grand Tappattoo Resort by 6 pm and get your hand and enjoy the dinner.

Q6: Can I purchase my registration card at one of the Poker Tour stops?

A6: Not all of the stops will be equipped to register riders so we will post the list of who is accepting registrations asap.

Q7: How much does the Poker Tour cost?

Q7: The \$75 preregistration fee (online) includes one hand. You can purchase as many extra hands as you like for \$10/hand. After Feb 15th the registration fee is \$90 either online or on the day of the event which includes one hand. Extra hands are \$10/hand.

Q8: What clubs does this event support?

A8: This event supports all our member clubs: Carling Trail Blazers, Cramadog Snowmobile Club, Dun-Ahmic Snow Riders, Magnetawan Ridge Runners, North East Georgian Bay Snowmobile Club, South Seguin Snowmobile Club, Six Star Snow Riders and West Muskoka Trail Riders

Q9: What is the route?

A9: Unlike a typical Poker Tour where you follow everyone around on one club's trails and stop at the checkpoints in a predetermined order, the Poker Tour 2020 is more of an opportunity to actually tour the sponsoring club trails, and the only mandatory stop is the final stop (see Q1 for available stops). You choose your own route based on the stops.

Q10: I don't have a snowmobile, can I still participate?

A10: Yes, many stops are in place so that you can use a vehicle other than a snowmobile (see Q1 for available stops).

Q11: What if I run out of time?

A11: Please keep in mind that this is NOT a race. Participants have from 9:00 am until 4:00 pm to complete the Poker Tour. The only stipulation is that you must make it to the final stop which is Grand Tappattoo by 6:00 pm otherwise your card will <u>not</u> be valid.

Q12: Who do I speak to if I have an issue to discuss?

A12: You may direct your inquiries to the official at the stop. If it can't be resolved to your satisfaction, please speak with Kim Hayes 705-746-7663. Any decision made by Kim will be considered final. Remember, we are here to have fun!

Q13: Do I need a valid OFSC permit to be on the trails during this event?

A13: Yes, you need a valid OFSC permit, valid insurance, valid vehicle registration, and valid operator registration to participate in the Snow Poker Run. OPP and Trail Patrols will be out in full force ensuring that this event is safe and compliant.

Q14: When is the Poker Tour 2020 officially over?

A14: The Poker Tour is officially over when you check-in at Grand Tappattoo by 6 pm.

Q15: What if I have registered and paid but can no longer participate, can I have a refund?

Q15: No, refunds will not be permitted. Don't forget that this is a fundraising event supporting Parry Sound Snowmobile District 10 and all it's member clubs.

Q16: I want to volunteer for this event and other club events. Who do I speak to?

Q16: Volunteers are always welcome, especially high school students who require volunteer hours to graduate. Please speak to your local club representative for further details. If you're unsure who that would be, call the District office 705-746-7663 and speak to Kim and she'll put you in contact with a club in your area.
